- Safely execute in hazardous and explosive area installation, maintenance, shutdown maintenance and repair of electrical equipment and process control, including air and gas compressors and gas turbines used for power generation, 6.9KV/0.47KV emergency diesel generators, 11KV, 6.9KV, and 0.47KV distribution transformer, switch gear and MCC, 0.47KV power distribution panel, Uninterruptable Power Supply (UPS), Battery Charger (BCH), battery, high and low voltage motor, high voltage water cooled and low Voltage Drive System (VDS), cathodic protection (impress and sacrificing current), navigation buoy, HVAC, heat tracing and fuel gas heaters, electrical submersible pumps motors (cryogenic LNG pump and deep well water pump) and apparatus used in the production, treatment, storage and distribution in agreement with DSLNG electrical maintenance policy & procedures to ensure production process is running well.
- As a work leader to lead and coordinate with other related discipline and section or department to execute job safely and effectively and to ensure hazards are identified and mitigation has been applied and covered in the PTW.
